Ontario Health Premium

The Ontario government introduced an Ontario Health Premium. This premium is based on taxable income for a taxation year, which is income after allowable deductions such as child care expenses, RRSP and pension contributions, union dues and non-taxable benefits.

Starting July 1, 2004, this premium is deducted from pay and pensions as part of their income tax.
